

Articles in the information mentioned were handed before  
the Lord the Ship and the court passing the dispatches and  
testimonies of the said Ship under the Seal of his  
Majesty of Sweden and the Town of Hano alias Hoads  
and all clearly satisfied that the said Sander Sanders and  
all the Seamen belonging to the said Ship and natural  
born Subjects of his Majesty of Sweden and the  
said Sander Sanders in open court confessed that the  
said Brig was made at Hano alias Hoads aforesaid and  
there by him taken in and Laden on board the said Ship  
and the said Sander Sanders nor his attorney Thomas  
Molloy aforesaid having nothing to alledge in Justifica-  
tion of the said Ship but the matters pronounced against  
the act of Parliament aforesaid in the said information  
mentioned this Court is all clearly satisfied that the said  
Ship is forfeited to go there with all her Guns tackle  
Furniture ammunition and apparell and do adjudge that  
the said Ship called the Brough of Hano alias Hoads  
to go there with all her guns tackle furniture ammunition  
and apparell be forfeited for the breach of the act  
of Parliament aforesaid according to the tenour and  
found in the said act of Parliament set forth and provided  
that is to say one third to his Majesty Charles the Second  
that now is King of England &c. one other third part  
to his Excellency Charles Calvert Esq<sup>r</sup> Capt<sup>l</sup> General  
and Chief Governour of this Province and the  
Remaining third Part to the said Benjamin Defer  
as performer due to him for performing and suing  
for the same as aforesaid. —

And the Court being Commanded by their Commission  
if the said Ship should be condemned to order and appoint  
two honest understanding men to appraise the said Ship  
to go there with all their guns tackle furniture ammunition  
and apparell: Upon their oathes the Court did appoint  
George Eger mate of the Ship Hopwell of London, and
