

I Catharine Weaver of Carroll County in the state of Maryland, for divers good causes & considerations, me thereunto moving, do hereby manumit, set free & release from slavery my coloured boy named Wesley Cooper (aged Two years in February last, past) his freedom to commence on the first day of March eighteen hundred and seventy-nine when he will be twenty-four years of age if then living — And from the said Wesley Cooper my coloured boy, I do hereby declare to be thenceforth free, manumitted & discharged from all manner of servitude or service, to me my heirs, Executors or administrators favor, from and after the time above stated —

To all whom it may concern be it known that I  
William S Brown of Carroll County in the State of  
Maryland for divers good Causes and Considerations in  
thereunto moving have released from Slavery, liberated  
manumitted and set free and by these presents do hereby  
release from Slavery, liberate manumitt and set free my  
negro man named John Adams being of the age of  
thirty one years and able to work and gain a sufficient  
livelihood and maintenance and him the said negro  
Man named John Adams I do declare to be  
henceforth free, manumitted and discharged from all  
manners of service a servitude to me my executors or  
administrators forever In Witness whereof I have  
hereunto subscribed my name and affixed my seal  
this 15<sup>th</sup> day of September 1843

I David Gamble of Frederick County in the State of  
Maryland for divers good causes and Considerations me  
thereunto moving, as also in further Consideration of One Dollar  
Current Money to me in hand paid, have released from Slavery  
Libertie Manumitted and set free, and by these presents  
do hereby release from Slavery, Libertie, Manumit and set free  
my negro Woman Agnes, being of the age of Thirty Eight years  
and able to work, and gain a sufficient Livelihood and main-  
tenance, and her the said negro Woman Agnes, I do declare  
to be henceforth free, Manumitted and discharged, from all  
Manner of servitude or service to me, my Executors, or adminis-  
trators forever. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto  
set my hand and affixed my seal, this fifth day of  
April in the Year Eighteen hundred & forty four
