

THIS INDENTURE Witnesseth, That Casper
Bauer hath bound & put his three Children viz William
George Bauer & Henry Bauer Servants to Capt Charles
Ridgely

for and in Consideration of the Sum of Twenty Three pounds
Eighteen Shillings Current Money paid by
M^r Charles Ridgely for the Freight and
other Charges of his said three Children in the Ship
Britannia (Merchant) from Rotterdam
to Maryland, as also for other good Causes, I the
said Casper Bauer hath bound and put
his said three Children and by these Presents doth bind and put
them Servant to the said Charles Ridgely

to serve him his Executors, and Assigns
from the Day of the Date hereof, for and during the full
Term of three Years from thence next ensuing,
During all which Term, the said Servant his said Master his
Executors or Assigns, faithfully shall serve, and that ho-
nestly and obediently in all Things, as a good and dutiful
Servant ought to do. AND the said Charles Ridgely
his Executors and Assigns, during
the said Term, shall find and provide for the said Servant
sufficient Meat, Drink, Apparel, Washing and
Lodging, And at the Expiration of this Indenture to give them the
Condemned Freedom Due a William Bauer being ten years Old the Eleventh
Day of September last George Bauer being five years Old the Eleventh Day
of November next, & Henry Bauer being two years Old the Ninth day
of May next

AND for the true Performance hereof, both the said Parties
bind themselves firmly unto each other by these Presents. In
Witness whereof they have hereunto interchangeably set their
Hands and Seals. Dated the Twentieth Day
of October in the Fifth Year of his Majesty's
Reign, Annoque Domini, 1764
