The only power, outside of was the power of a few water wheels in the streams along the New England coast. It was at these sites that our first industrial towns and cities grew. Then came steam power, and since steam power could not be transported easily, the workers flocked to where a wide geographical area.

> This led naturally to the rediscovery of small towns as ideal factory sites. industrial worker did not till the soil.

During the last 40 years the population of the United States has almost doubled. For every 100 persons living in the United States in 1890, there were 195 in 1930. But for every 100 farmers in 1890, there were only 124 in 1930. In other words, there was an actual decrease in the farm population in those four decades. On the other hand, the population of towns of 25,000 to 500,000 inhabitants increased 300 times crease of 200 times. The figures are still more striking in the larger cities of half a million to a million in population. Here the increase has been 700 times what it was in 1890. We were in 1930 a decidedly more urban than rural population.

Now, due to the depression, we are in the midst of a redistribution of population. It has been estimated that moving from the cities to the land. 
