Farmers Urged To Report Losses Promptly

Following a suggestion inaugurated by the Maryland Poultry Council to lessen raids on farmyard fowl, the State Police, the State Grange, the Maryland Farm Bureau and the office of Sheriff T. Herbert Everett will cooperate in an effort to catch chicken thieves operating in Queen Anne's county.

County Agent Kenneth W. Baker advises that promptness in reporting losses may prove an important factor in apprehending culprits. He urges that as soon as a theft is discovered, the poultry owner should get in touch with the Sheriff's office by telephone at once. In the event that the Sheriff is not available, Mr. Baker should be call-

The farmer should furnish a description of the tattoo symbol, if any, used on the poultry, the kind of fowl taken, the number, and when and where the stealing occurred, as far as may be

Poultry thefts have been fairly numerous in Queen Anne's county in the past two years, especially in the upper county and along the borderline of Caroline and Talbot counties.
