Brakes Are Greatest Feature Safety

Must Have Six Times Horsepower Of Engines For Safety

Brakes have more to do with the safety of a motor car than any other feature of car design, according to Pontiac engineers. Top speed is regulated pretty much by the efficiency

of the brakes. Brakes and the driver should act as one. In a sense, brakes are but an extension to a driver's right leg. They express the motorist's mental and muscular reactions just as accurately and sensitively as a pencil or a pair of skates strapped on his feet. If they do their job properly, they must respond instantly and in perfect coordination with the dirver's mental impulses. Brakes, even hydraulic ones, are far

less impressive to the eye than a 100horsepower engine under the hood, yet the brakes must undo the work of the engine in building up speed in a fraction of the time the engine requires. If brakes were no more powerful than the engine and took as long to slow up a car as to speed it up., car speeds

would be limited to one-eighth of their present rates. To offset persent high speeds, brakes, such as in the Pontiac, deliver 650 horsepower as against the engines's 100. Shoving a 10-horsepower engine into

full energy, thrity-five seconds are required to bring a car from a standing start to 80 miles an hour. But since no one would be willing always to wait 35 seconds to come to a stop from an 80-mile speed, the problem for auto ensigned to halt a car with the promptness necessary for safety.
