Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 72; respiration, 22; temperature, 98.6; height, 5 feet 10 inches; weight, 140 pounds; age, 65 years. The physical condition fair.

Malarial fever - no physical evidence of malarial fever - no enlargement of spleen or liver - without swelling or atrophy - there is slight stiffness and pain upon flexion of body - no disease of kidneys - heart normal - disease of eyes - field normal - cornea normal - pupil - pupils of average normal size and refracted to right axis - vision - both eyes - 20 - right eye 20 - left eye 20

Prognosis - no objectionable evidence of disease - no enlargement of spleen or atrophy - vision - normal - no disease of kidneys - heart normal - disease of eyes - field normal - cornea normal - pupil - pupils of average normal size and refracted to right axis - vision - both eyes - 20 - right eye 20 - left eye 20

Also - there is no abnormal fundus of the eye, about 1/4 of an inch in circumference. The humor is aqueous, humors are normal. No enlarged - no bleeding or hemorrhage in any part of the eye - no disease of retina or optic nerve. Also - there is no abnormal fundus of the eye.
