BE IT REMEMBERED, That on this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of December

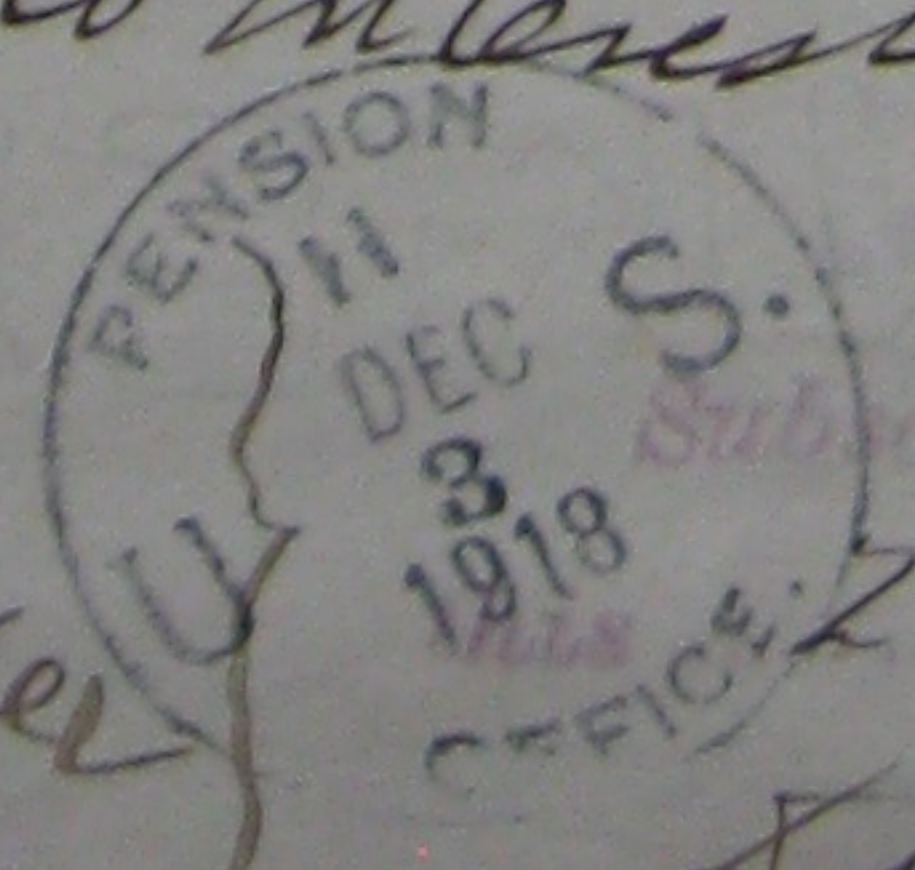
A. D., 1918, before me, the subscriber, a JUSTICE OF THE PEACE

E. 30 U.S.C. Int. and made oath in due form of law that I was born and raised in Howard

County Maryland, living on the same farm with  
the Claimant and her deceased husband Henry Robinson  
prior to either of them becoming of marriageable age,  
And do know of My own personal knowledge from  
My associations, that neither were married prior to  
their marriage to each other. I was personally present
