I have no interest in this claim.

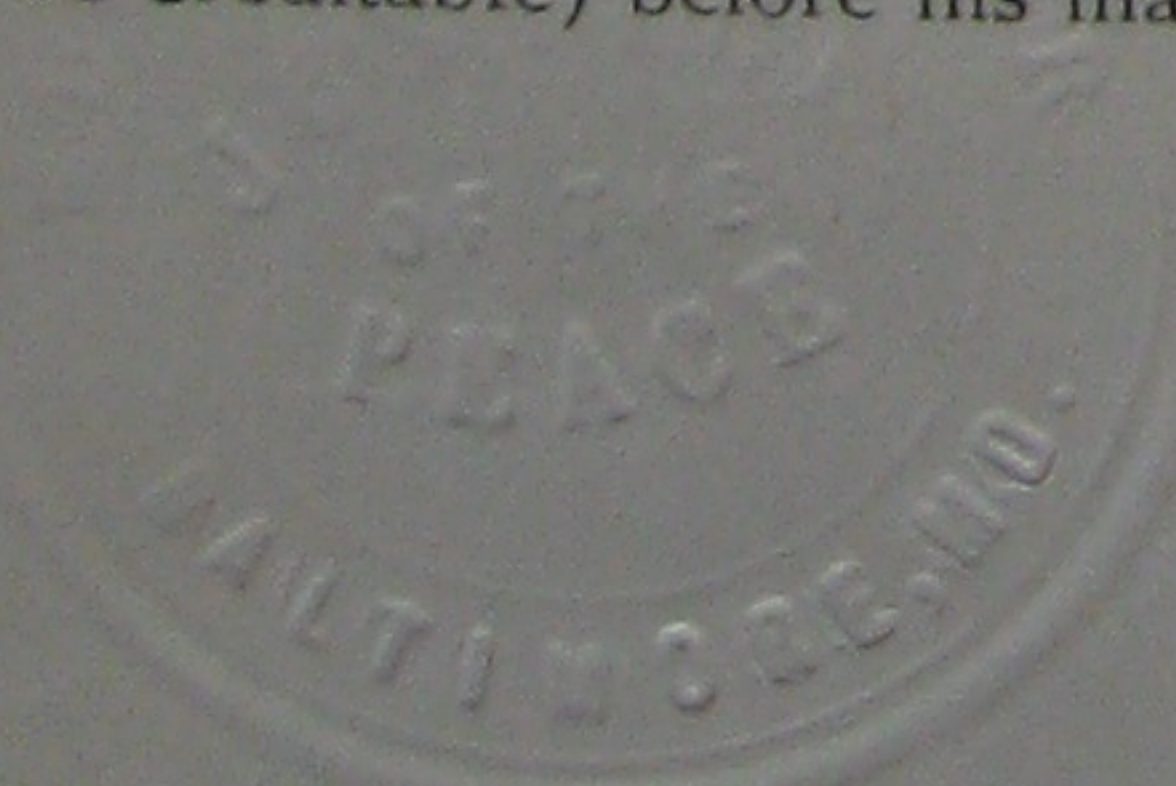
