



Declaration for an Original Invalid Pension.

NOTE.—To be executed before a Court of Record or some officer thereof having custody of its seal, a Notary Public or Justice of the Peace whose official signature shall be verified by his official seal, and in case he has none, his signature and official character shall be certified by a Clerk of a Court of Record or a City or County Clerk.

personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the County and State aforesaid Moses Shipley aged 35 years, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical

who was ENROLLED as a Private on the 26 day of Nov, 1866, in Company H of the 9th Regiment of U.S.C.T. commanded by John W. ... and was honorably DISCHARGED at

New Orleans on the 26 day of Nov, 1866. That his personal description is as follows: Age 29 years; height 5 feet 8 inches; complexion Brown

hair black; eyes black. That while a member of the organization aforesaid, in the service and in the line of duty at Cromwell in the State of Texas

on or about the 17 day of Sept, 1866, he was injured (Here state the name or nature of disease, or the location of wound or injury. If disabled by disease, state fully its cause; if by wound or injury, the precise manner in which received.) of insanity during latter part of this service.

That he was treated in hospitals as follows: none (Here state the names or numbers, and the localities of all hospitals in which treated, and the dates of treatment.)

That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above (Here state what the service was, whether prior or subsequent to that stated above and the dates at which it began and ended.)

That he has not been in the military or naval service of the United States since the 26 day of Nov, 1866

That since leaving the service this applicant has resided in the City of Baltimore in the State of Md, and that his occupation has been that of a laborer

That prior to his entry into the service above-named he was a man of good, sound, physical health, being when enrolled a man. That he is now totally disabled from obtaining his subsistence by manual labor by reason of his injuries, above described, received in the service of the United States; and he therefore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the invalid pension roll of the United States. He hereby appoints with full power of substitution and revocation,
