

Society or their Agent, they shall pay the
said owner twenty-five dollars. (\$25)

11th One half of the charter money shall be
paid in three months after the signa-
ture of this deed; and the other half, to-
gether with the money for provisions, in
six months after the same signature,
or as soon after the expiration of six
months as advice shall be received of
the arrival and landing of the said per-
sons and things at Liberia.

12th The Society shall furnish the passen-
gers with cooking utensils, as in the
former voyage; the cabouse excepted,
which shall be furnished by the owner
of the Brig.

And to the true and faithful per-
formance of all and singular these
covenants and agreements, each of the
aforenamed parties binds and obliges
himself; his executors and adminis-
trators, firmly by these presents, in the
penal sum of five thousand dollars.
(\$5000.) In witness whereof they have
