

Memorandum of Agreement made between John
Kennedy Acting Agent for the Am. Col. Society - of
the one part & Reynolds Knox on the other
part. -

The said Reynolds Knox agrees to do the
frame work of two buildings each 70 feet
long, & twenty feet wide with framing for
6 doors in each, One story high with Rafters
fourteen feet long, to be done & finished in
a workmanlike manner, and he hereby agrees
to have the two buildings finished and
ready for delivery on or before Saturday
the 24th Inst. (Nov 1832) excepting the work
should be unavoidably hindered by the
inclemency of the weather. - & when so
finished & ready for delivery said J. Kennedy
on behalf of the Am. Col. Socy agrees
to pay for the same by an order on the
Treas^r of the Maryland Colonization & Emig-
ration Society - or on Mr Sheppard the sum
of sixty five dollars each say in all one
hundred & thirty dollars. Signed this 16 Nov 1832
