DAYS OF OLD GRIST MILL MAN ATE THE BEST OF WHEAT

Bread is, and always has been the staple food of the people. Wheat bread is found in every home, the millionaire and the humblest citizens alike, and it is on the table three times a day.

These mills, often built on the water courses, had a canal leading from up stream called the "mill race," that brought the water to the overshot wheel which operated the machinery and gave the power for the grinding.

These old mills were equipped to do all kinds of grinding—flour, corn meal, buckwheat and by products of grain was converted into feed for horses and cattle.

In those days there were no such thing as going to the store to purchase a sack of flour or loaf of bread. It would have been just as appropriate to go to the blacksmith to buy a hat.

But to get back to the changes in wheat bread—the kind we have been speaking of. It wasn't white; indeed it was rather dark, but it was sweet and contained the finest of the wheat.

If our readers would use more whole or part wheat bread they would find themselves enjoying better health. The "white" bread is good to look at but is lifeless.

DR. TULL WILL CASE POSTPONED

Trial of the case in which an attempt is being made to break the will of Dr. Edw. E. Tull, millionaire surgeon, Monday was delayed until the next jury term of the Circuit Court for Somerset county, which will open in April.

The delay was forced by attorneys for Dr. Tull's half-brother, Robert H. Jones, of Fairmount, and his sister, Mrs. J. Henry Baker, of Baltimore.

When the case was called the attorneys announced that they had taken two points from the Orphans' Court to the Maryland Court of Appeals, which must decide whether Dr. Tull understood the contents of the will at the time of its execution and whether the document "was read to or by him, or known to him at or before the time of the alleged execution thereof."

Under the will the bulk of the surgeon's estate is left to 14-year-old Edna Davy, a Somerset farmer's daughter, whose mother was a distant cousin of Dr. Tull, while a \$3,600 annuity for life is left to Edna's sister Ruth Davy.

Neither Mr. Jones nor Mrs. Baker was mentioned in the division of the estate, said to be worth \$1,000,000, which Dr. Tull amassed in New York.

Pavement Ordinance

ORDINANCE NO. 41 PASSED SEPT. 5th, 1927

Be it enacted and ordained, That pavement or side walk be laid on the South west side of Cannon street between Queen and Princes Street and Front Street. That the cost of two feet of same be paid by the Commissioners of Chestertown, and the balance of the said cost to be paid by the property owners adjoining said pavement or side walk; and the share of the cost of the respective property owners to be a lien upon the said respective properties to be collected in the same manner as taxes now levied under the provision of Article 81 of the Code of Public General Laws.

Sewer Ordinance

ORDINANCE NO. 42 PASSED SEPT. 5, 1927

Be it enacted and ordained, That all owners of property abutting the public sewer line of Chestertown and within a distance of 200 feet from said sewer line shall connect any residence, store or dwelling to said sewer for purpose of sewerage disposal of all privies or places where human excrement is deposited. That all persons failing to so connect with the sewer thirty days after written notice given them shall pay a fine of \$10.00, and every twenty-four hours after notice shall be considered a separate offense, said fine and costs of prosecution to be collected as provided by law.

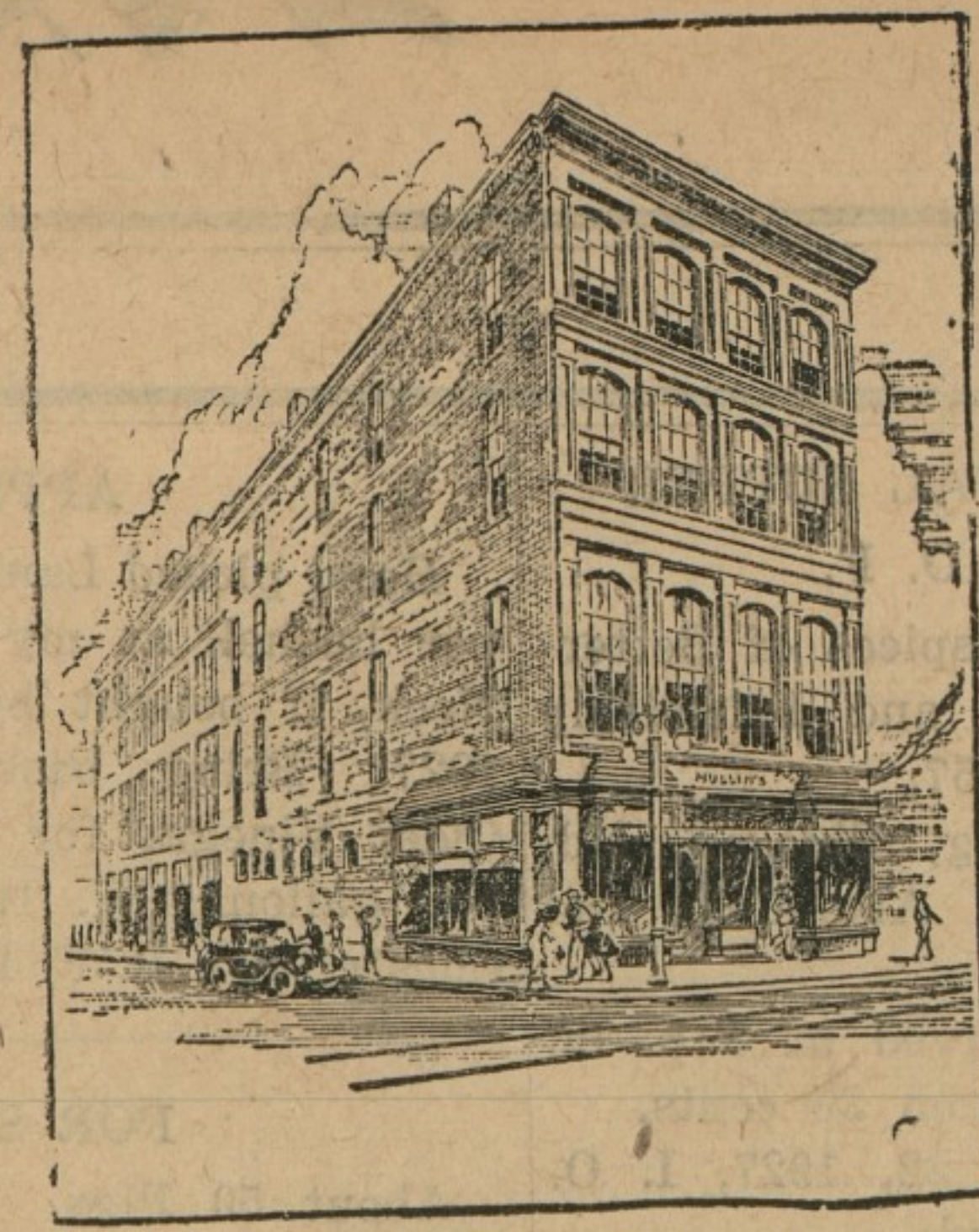

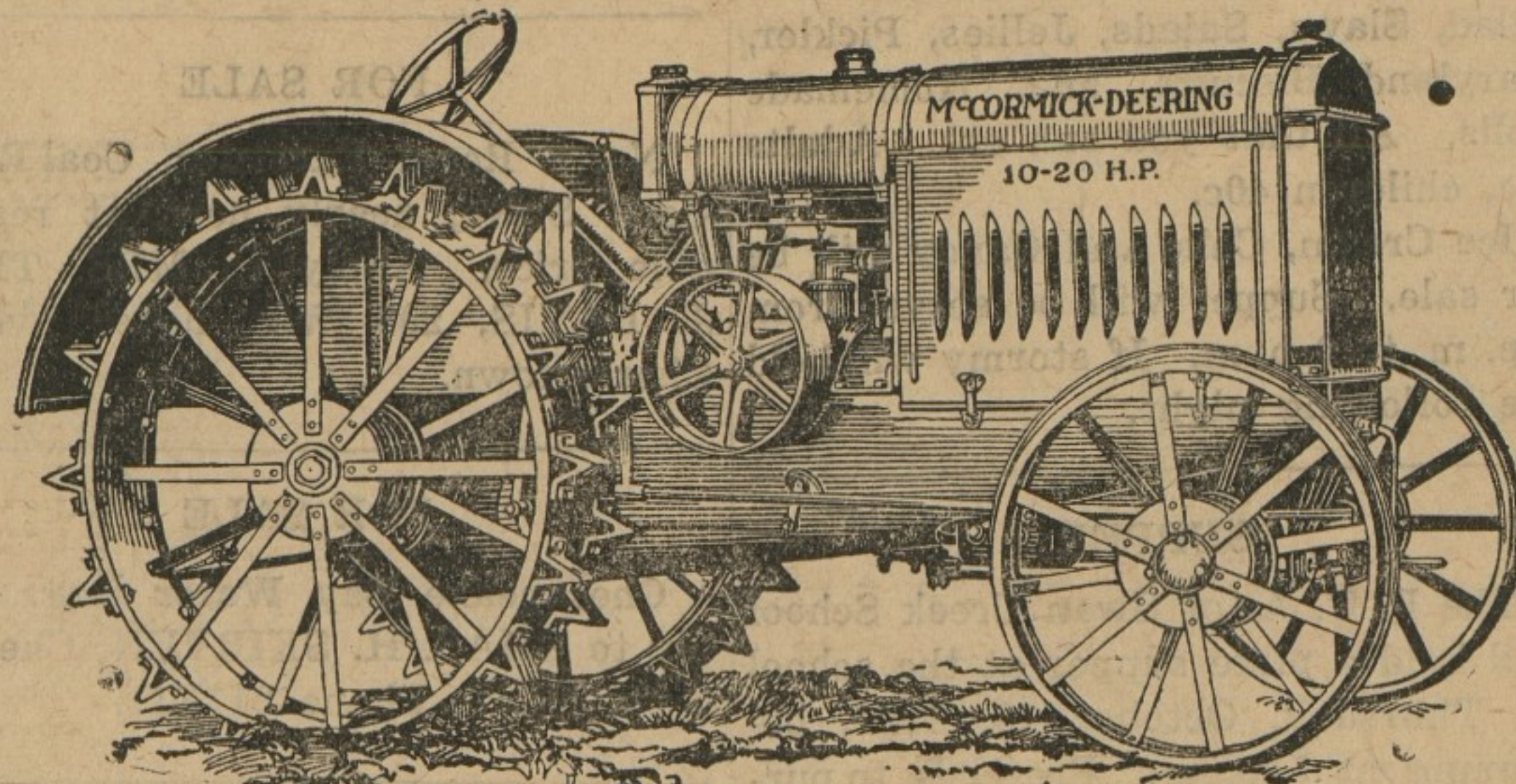
