In the Record of proceedings of the same Court among others is the following to wit.

Zachariah Maccubbin vs Alexander Hamilton Be it remembered that heretofore to wit on the eight day of July Anno Domini seventeen hundred and ninety six the aforesaid Zachariah Maccubbin sued out of the State of Maryland's High Court of Chancery the Writ of the State of Maryland of Error directed to the Honorable the Judges of the General Court in the words and figures following to wit.

Maryland etc. The State of Maryland to the Honorable the Judges of the General Court Greeting, Because in the record and procefs and also in the rendering of Judgment on a certain Action brought by Alexander Hamilton against Zachariah Maccubbin for the sum of five hundred and ninety seven six Shillings current money and eight hundred and five pounds of Tobacco costs of Suit, at a General Court held before you our said Judges at May Term last, manifest Error as it is said has happened to the great damage of the said Zachariah Maccubbin as of his complaint we have received a we being willing that the Errors if any there be should be duly corrected and full and speedy Justice done to the said Zachariah Maccubbin, In this Behalf command you that if Judgment be thereof rendered that then the record and procefs aforesaid with all things thereunto relating under your Seals distinctly and openly you send and this Writ so that the same may be had before the Judges of our high Court of Appeals at Annapolis the second Tuesday in November next, that the record and procefs aforesaid being inspected into we may further do therein for the correcting that Error which of right and according to the Laws and customs of this State may be done. Witness the Honorable Alexander Bonte Hanson Chancellor this twenty eighth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six.
