These documents supply a link in a series of Port of Entry Records of Colonial Maryland.

They were rescued in a mutilated condition by the late Albert Levin Richardson when about to be destroyed, and published by him for preservation, in the Maryland Original Research Bulletin No. 3, in the year 1915.

In accordance with Mr. Richardson's desire, they were deposited with the manuscript Archives of the State in the custody of the Maryland Historical Society on January 11th, 1931 by Mrs. Richardson and have been repaired by that Society.

An account of the above acquisition was spread upon the minutes of the Society and a letter of acknowledgment sent Mrs. Richardson, who has forwarded a copy of the correspondence to Governor Albert C. Ritchie of Maryland for his information regarding these historical important State Documents.
