## RESOLUTIONS

PASSED AT THE EXTRA SESSION, HELD JULY, 1840.

1. Resolved by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, That the Register be and he is hereby authorised to pay, with the approbation of the Mayor, to James Kean, Sheriff of Harford County, the sum of one hundred and seventy-four dollars and seventy-four cents, being the amount due by the City to the said Sheriff for costs in cases removed from the City Court of Baltimore to Harford County Court, the same to be paid out of the tax for certain expenses of Courts, Coroners, &c.

*And be it further resolved*, That the Register be and he is hereby authorised to pay, with the approbation of the Mayor, to the former Sheriff of Harford County, the amount of his claim for similar costs, whenever his account shall be presented properly authenticated, the same to be paid out of the tax aforesaid.
