

Trishams (Medge) Surveyed for Richard Fresham the 29<sup>th</sup>  
October 1684. Lying in Baltimore County and up on the South  
West Branch of a River called Bush River. Beginning at a  
Bounded Oak standing in a Level being a bounded Tree of the Land  
called Good Hope & running thence parallel with the said Land  
E. N. E. 400 ff - then running S. S. E. 134 ff - to a Bounded  
Red Oak in a Ridge then running W. S. W. 600 ff - to another  
Marked Red Oak then running N. N. W. 174 ff - till it intersects  
the Land called Magaths Forrest then running & bounding on the  
said Land E. N. E. 156 ff - to a Bounded Red Oak the first  
Bounded Tree of the Land called Gibsons Park lastly running  
by a direct Line to the first Bounded Tree cont. & laid out for
