

Proposition of D. Horsey to J. Lee - 1127

To pay the debt & interest, say \$4020, in land
at sixty dollars the acre, & as much more
land in addition thereto as will equal
acre for acre, all the land belonging
to the said J. Lee which may lay
between the line in the Mountain
land of D. Horsey & J. Lee and the
stone boundary at the corner of
David Arnold's land which is a call
in the new road, being all the
land of the said J. Lee lying East
