During the year of 1898 there were 127 examinations of applicants for appointment. Of this number 116 were found physically qualified, while 11 were rejected.

During the year of 1898 there were 50 surveys held, 32 of those being placed upon the retired list, 11 returned to active duty and 7 dropped from the roll.

During the year the Police Physicians attended several of the officers who received severe injuries and required surgical treatment, detailed accounts of which were embodied in their weekly reports to the Board.
