The Commissioners being met, are of opinion that Calvert Street should have the same width with its extension South into the Basin, as it has at its intersection with Baltimore Street, which width we find by the Records of the Town, to be four Perches - and we further certify, that from the Evidence we could collect, and the most exact Measurements, we are of Opinion, that the West Front of Skinner Connell's House is properly lined on Calvert Street.
