

and one moiety of the money arising therefrom; after deducting the cost & charges shall be paid to the Treasurer of the County in which such seizure & condemnation shall take place for the use of the commonwealth and the other moiety thereof to the inspector or his deputy who shall seize and prosecute the same to judgment.

Sec 9 Be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid that the fees given and the fines inflicted by virtue of this act, shall be recovered in the same manner as debts of like value are recovered by the laws of this State; and all the F. fines, except such as may be incurred by the inspector or his deputies shall be distributed in the manner herein before directed, with regard to the articles forfeited.

Sec 10 Be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid that this act shall continue & be in force for the term of two years, & from thence to the end of the next Session of the General Assembly of this Commonwealth.
