

Richard Burmiston came on board of the said Shipp to appraise  
the said Shipp burch of staves all goods to gather with all  
her guns tackle furnished ammunition, and apparel, and  
to go on board the said Shipp and an inventory of  
apprizement of the same to returne to the clerke of this  
court under their hands and seals with all convenient  
speed and that they might do and performe the same  
honestly and justly, and according to the best of their skill  
judgment and knowledges the said appraisors were sworn and  
in open Court to do and performe the same.

And the same day the said appraisors to wit George Eger  
and Richard Burmiston returned to Robert Bridgely clerke  
of the said court the apprizement of the said Shipp under  
their hands and seals which followeth in these words (viz)  
Maryland the 10<sup>th</sup> of february 1672 an inventory of  
the materials of the Shipp burch of staves now lying  
in Wicocomoco Towne as they were surveyed by us underwritten  
the day and yeare abovesaid, comprised for the Shipp hull  
twenty five or thirty yeares old vallued at one hundred and  
four pounds maine mast foremast bowsprit foretop  
mast old mainetop mast. miffon mast broken and yards  
vallued at eight pounds standing Rigging halfe wouen  
Running rigging for the generall part very old twelve  
pounds two cables halfe wouen one five yach Rudder halfe  
wouen one new warpe two peeces of old junked vallued  
at fifteen pounds some guns small and great weighing  
one with the other light hundred pound a pece two hundred  
pound of powder seven old muskets six ordinary Pistols  
seven old swords vallued at thirty pounds four anchors  
weighing one with the other six hundred pounds a pece  
vallued at eight pounds three small bottles with the cockpit  
other materials vallued at one pound two payor of  
handkerowes vallued at one pound ten Shillings and some  
of sayles more then halfe wouen with some old Spare  
sayles vallued at twelve pounds ten Shillings and old long  
boats and one very old yauld vallued at seven pounds  
ten Shillings Summe totall one hundred ninety nine pounds
