In accordance with your request of June 5 we are enclosing herewith a copy of the program under which architects for the new State Library were selected.

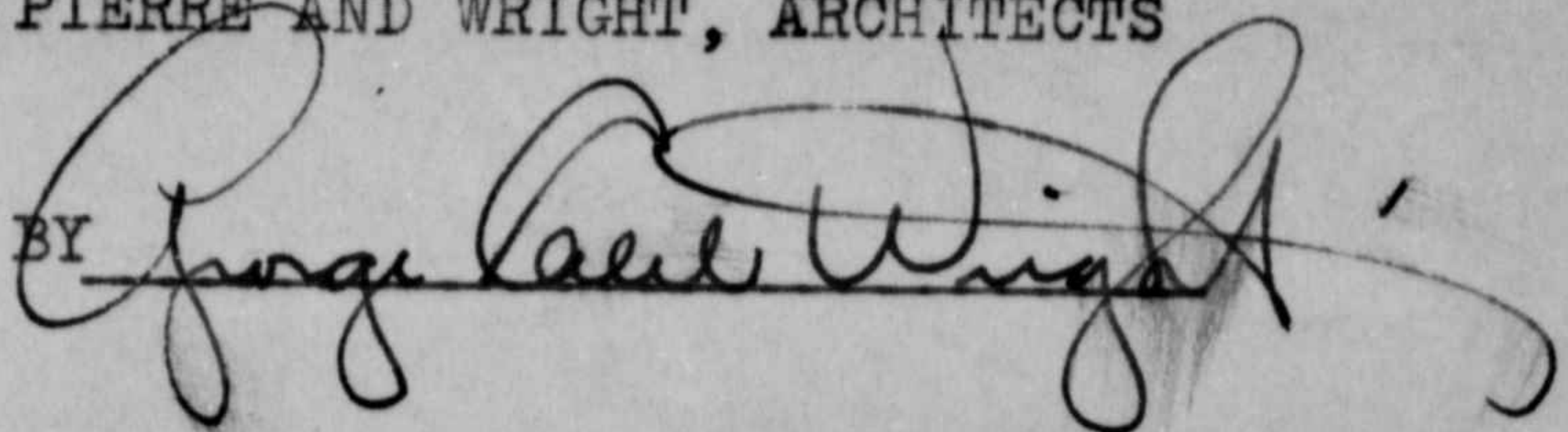
