In addition to the accommodations needed ~~to satisfy these factors, two other requirements were~~ ^{in developing a department of archives according to these principles} there were in this case two other requisites ~~present~~:--exhibition rooms where public interest in the archives ~~may~~ ^{might} be stimulated ~~aroused~~ by the display of especially important documents, and quarters for the state Land Office, which had been functioning since 1680 and was already possessed of much valuable material.

The ^{plan} ~~arrangement~~ resulting from the attempt to satisfy these demands produced a building having a six tier ~~fireproof~~ ^{room} stack surrounded on three sides by a basement and two stories ^{with an attic story in front only} for the accommodation of ~~the administrative and research requirements.~~
