The following order was passed by the Board:
 Orders.

That the Captains of each district shall require their Lieutenants to conform to Rule 2 Lieutenants duties, by patrolling each day and night, certain portions of their district.

At night, in the absence of the Captain, the Lieutenant on duty would be at liberty to designate the Sergeant to assume temporary command in his absence.

The Marshal is instructed to inform the Lieutenants, that this privilege must not be abused and their absence from the Station House must be always in the discharge of their duty.
