Officer Augustus Haw E.D. reported by Sergt. Wilson for sleeping on his beat, admitted the charge and was fined \$2.50.

Officer Chas. E. Cole E.D. reported by Lieut. Aaron for sleeping on his beat. The charge was sustained and it being the seventh time that he has been arraigned, he was dismissed from the Force.

Officer Backman S.D. reported by Sergt. Ford with neglect of duty and being off his beat admitted the charge and was fined \$2.50.

Officer John Maylaw M.D. reported by Sergt. Gordon for sleeping on his beat admitted the charge and was fined \$2.50.

Officer D. M. Cordace E.D. charged by Sergt. Wilson with abusing & threatening a brother Officer. The charge was fully sustained and Cordace was dismissed from the Force.

Officer Thomas James E.D. reported by Sergt. Jay for intoxication and fighting in the street, while on leave of absence and in citizen's dress; the case was held for further consideration, in consequence of his past reputation as prosecuted by his Superior Officer.
