They further decide that officers on leave of absence should be instructed that permission to take off their uniform does not impair the power to arrest or release them of their obligation to conform to the rules laid down for their government; this note will be read to the entire force of the Eastern District, and is to be considered as a public reprimand of Officer Thomas Jones' disrespectful conduct.
