District Reports Received and Examined.

Officer Hull S.D. was charged with striking Mr. Clements with a billy at the Brickmakers pic-nic on Saturday last whilst endeavoring to effect his arrest, using unnecessary violence, whilst no necessity existed for such severity. The Board dismissed the charge against the Officer, but cautioned him against the use of the billy except for self protection and not to strike on the head but ^{if practicable} on the arms or some other portion of the body - where so much injury to the party is not likely to ensue, if it is found necessary to use it.

Sergt Joseph Tatham E.D. reported for conduct unbecoming an Officer by violating Sec. 4th Art. on Sergts duty Rules Reg. for former Police Force. He was found guilty of the charge dismissed from the Force.

Officer A. J. Cruise E.D. reported for neglect of duty by leaving his beat and going buggy riding, was found guilty of the charge and dismissed from the Force.

Officer Adam Wright E.D. reported for being asleep on his beat admitted the charge and was fined \$2.00.

Officer J. M. Carrino E.D. reported for failing to make his rounds in proper time was fined \$2.00.

Officer C. Tully M.D. reported by Sergt. Gordon asleep at 5 min before four A.M. Aug. 29th; also reported by Sergt. Short S.D. for being intoxicated on the street on yesterday about 10 o'clock. was found guilty of the charges and dismissed from the Force.

Officer P. Bogdesang reported by Sergt. Bowens S.D. for being asleep at 2 A.M. 29th. who admitted the charge
