Officer C. Birkhead Md. reported by Supt Morgan for being off his beat from 2 to 5 o'clock and going to his own dwelling was found guilty and it was ordered that he should be removed to another beat and be fined Two dollars.

Officer W. L. Emerson Md. reported by Supt Gordon with leaving his beat, and going home without permission, admitting the charge, but in consequence of the alleged extreme illness of his wife the Board finis him but Five dollars.
