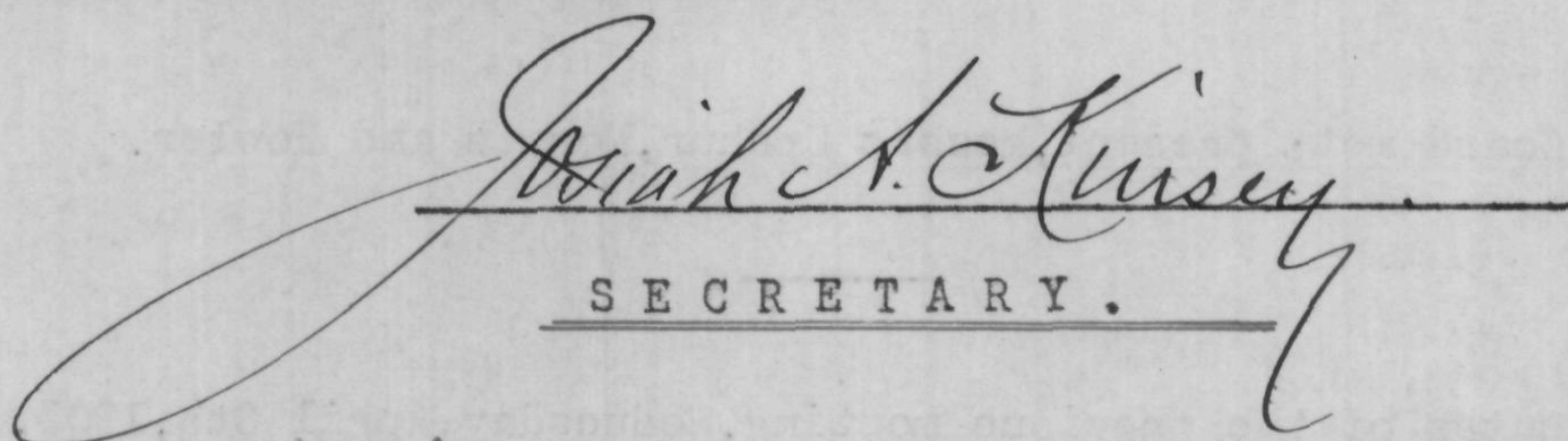


The receipts to-day were as follows:-
