

Sir:-

Regarding the request of the Edmondson Terrace Improvement Association, for a patrol box in their neighborhood. I have carefully looked over the situation and find that this locality has been built up with a nice class of houses. The nearest box west is located at the corner of Calverton road and Lanvale street, Calverton. The nearest box east it located at the corner of Harlem avenue and Kirby Lane. The nearest box north is located at the corner Lafayette avenue and Appleton street.

In view of the thickly populated neighborhood and the nice class of houses and the above mentioned patrol boxes so distinctly located, I recommend that a patrol box be placed at the corner of Canseway street and Edmondson avenue or on Canseway street just north of Edmondson avenue. This will be on the dividing line of the two districts, the Northwestern and Southwestern District, and would be used by both districts.
