

Appointment of Probationer.

Gentlemen:-

I desire to call your attention to the condition of the dump to the north side of Edmondson ave., east of the P.B. & W. bridge. This matter has been taken up with the Health Department and with the Commissioner of Street Cleaning a number of times and up to this writing nothing has been done to afford us relief from the odors arising from this nuisance. We received a short time since a communication from the Commissioner of Street Cleaning, forwarded to us by the Mayor's Secretary, in which the Commissioner stated that he had ordered dumping at this point stopped, but that dumping of miscellaneous refuse was being done from time to time by private parties. We would greatly appreciate anything you could do to abate this nuisance and prevent any further dumping.
