A communication, as follows, was received:

"Baltimore, July 31, 1911.

To The Board of Police Commissioners

Having received application in writing from the property owners in the Five Hundred Block North Bond street, as recognized by Ordinance #654, approved April 11, 1911, paragraph 7. I herewith declare said block open to White Residents ONLY, as requested in said application, and subject to regulations of above named ordinance.
