Board met; present, Messrs. Wheltle and Tome.

The minutes of the previous meeting, Monday, August 14, 1911,

were read, approved and adopted.

Trials.

Patrolman John D. Schmidt, Northwestern District, was tried upon charge, as follows:-

C h a r g e :

"Neglect of duty in failing to arrest one Joseph R. Schuster at the request of J. Edgar Keefer on the morning of Sunday, August 13th., 1911, about 12:40 a.m. The said Schuster having assaulted J. Edgar Keefer."

The charge was dismissed.

Sergeant John Reth, Northern District, was tried upon charge, as follows:

C h a r g e :

NEGLECT OF DUTY:

Specifications.

1st.....In that he on August 13th., 1911, called in from Box #16, corner Guilford ave. & 25th. street, at 11:45 a.m., going to dinner, and called in from said box returning from dinner at 1:35 p.m; the said box #16 being approximately a mile from his bailiwick and by this arrangement the said sergeant consumed more than two hours for dinner, leaving his post ahead of time going to dinner and arriving on his post behind time returning from dinner. (Time allowed by the rules one hour and thirty minutes.)

2nd.....In that he on August 14th., 1911, called in from said Box #16, at 11:46 a.m., going to dinner, and called in from said box returning from dinner at 1:39 the said Box #16 being approximately a mile from his bailiwick and by this arrangement the said sergeant consumed one hour and 53 minutes for dinner; leaving his post ahead of time going to dinner and arriving on his post behind time returning from dinner. (Time allowed by the rules one hour and thirty minutes.)

3rd.....In that he, on August 15th., 1911, called in from said Box #16, at 11:51 a.m., going to dinner, and called in from said box returning from dinner at 1:37 p.m., the said box being approximately a mile from his bailiwick, and by this arrangement the said sergeant consumed one hour and 46 minutes for dinner; leaving his post ahead of time going to dinner and arriving on his post behind time returning from dinner. (Time allowed by the rules one hour and thirty minutes.)

The charge was dismissed.
