The hearing of the charges preferred by Samuel Shanks, 4 N. Poppleton street, against Patrolman Thomas H. McManus, Western District, which was begun August 21st., 1911, and adjourned until 10 o'clock this morning, was resumed.

After hearing all the testimony offered for and against the officer the Board came to the conclusion that no case has been made out against the officer and the charges were dismissed.

Transfer.

The Board was of the opinion, however, that the interests of the service would be best served by removing Patrolman Thomas H. McManus from his present post to some other post of the Western District, and it was so ordered.
