

and the ballots therein fully counted, and such notes and memoranda made by said Grand Jury as may by that body be deemed necessary as to all the contents of said Boxes, that the contents shall be returned to said Boxes which shall be locked by the Foreman of the Grand Jury and sealed in the manner provided by law for sealing the Ballot boxes, upon which seal shall be written the names of the Foreman of the Grand Jury and one of the Board of Supervisors of Election and one of the Board of Police Commissioners, after which said keys shall be by said officials returned to their respective custodians, and that during the entire examination and proceeding from the time of the production of said keys and boxes to the time of their re-delivery, one member of each of said Boards shall be present in the Grand Jury Room, and the Grand Jury are directed to cause the Grand Jury Stenographer to keep detailed and minute records of all proceedings regarding the production, opening and closing and sealing and re-delivery of said boxes and the examination of the contents thereof.
