

the production of said keys and boxes to the time of their re-delivery, one member of each of said Board shall be present in the Grand Jury Room, and the Grand Jury are directed to cause the Grand Jury Stenographer to keep detailed and minute records of all proceedings regarding the production, opening and closing and sealing and re-delivery of said boxes and the examination of the contents thereof.

The fifth and fifteenth precincts of the Seventh Ward;

The first, fourteenth and fifteenth precincts of the Eighth Ward;

The eleventh and twelfth precincts of the Ninth Ward;

The second and ninth precincts of the Twenty-second Ward

The fifth and twelfth precincts of the Twenty-third Ward and

the eleventh precinct of the Second Ward.
