In the matter of complaint from Otto Duker & Company, September 25th., with respect to depredations to their factory building President street and Canton avenue, a report, as follows, was received, read and ordered filed, see Exhibit No. 3586:-

Gentlemen:-

In connection with the attached communication from Messrs. Otto Duker & Co., in which they complain as to depredation to their property, beg to say that I referred the matter to Cap't George League, Eastern District, with instructions to pay especial attention to this plant, ascertain, if possible, the names of the guilty party, or parties, and to keep this place under surveillance in order to prevent future depredations.
