

me for having been in a house of an immoral character while in uniform, respectfully petition your Honorable Board to re-open my case and allow me to produce such evidence which I shall be able to adduce in support of the following facts: facts which I believe had I offered at the trial of my case would have tended to mitigate the offense for which I was dismissed.

Your petitioner avers that during the thirteen years he was a member of the department he was never before the board for any serious trouble or difficulty; that he always possessed the confidence and good will of his superior officers, as well as the respect and esteem of his brother officers; that while he fully realizes the gravity of his mistake, your Petitioner avers that his visit to the house in question was with the consent of his wife. Several years ago his wife was compelled to undergo a serious operation which resulted in the complete removal of all of her generative organs. That since that time there has been no family relation between them, and that his wife was fully cognizant of his occasional visits to houses of this character - although this was the first time while in uniform. Your petitioner herewith attaches a copy of the hospital record showing the exact nature of the aforesaid operation.

Your Petitioner now fully realizes the position he occupied when he was tried before your Honorable Board, although he did not do so at that time, and he believes that had he realized the facts hereinbefore stated your Honorable Board would have inflicted a less penalty than dismissal. Your Petitioner therefore respectfully requests that his case may be re-opened and that he may be permitted to adduce the evidence hereinbefore referred to together with such other testimony as his counsel may advise him to be material to the merits of his case.
