Ballot Boxes, - Investigation by  
Grand Jury.

Answer to the order of the Criminal Court, as recorded in the proceedings of November 9th., 1911, as follows, signed by the three members of the Board of Police Commissioners and sworn to by President Whelple was transmitted to His Honor, Henry Duffy, Judge of the Criminal Court of Baltimore City.

In the Criminal Court of Baltimore City.

In the matter of the petition and report of the Grand Jury of the City of Baltimore, filed on the 9th. day of November, 1911, relative to the inspection and production of ballot boxes used in the City of Baltimore at the Municipal Primary Election on April 4th. 1911, and at the General Election on the 2nd. day of May, 1911.

The Board of Police Commissioners of Baltimore City show unto the Honorable Henry Duffy, Judge of the Criminal Court of Baltimore City, in reply to the order passed by the said Court on the 9th. day of November, 1911, ordering and directing the said Board of Police Commissioners to surrender and deliver up certain designated ballot boxes which has been used in the Primary Election held in the City of Baltimore on April 4th., 1911, and to surrender and deliver up certain designated ballot boxes which had been used in the General Election held in the City of Baltimore on the 2nd. day of May, 1911:

FIRST: The Board of Police Commissioners show unto your
