were read, approved and adopted.Elections.Ballot Boxes.Investigation by Grand Jury.

In the matter of the order of His Honor, Judge Duffy, for the production before the Grand Jury of certain ballot boxes used in the General Election of May 2nd., 1911, as referred to in the proceedings of November 9, 1911,

The Secretary reported that on Friday, November 17, 1911, Mr. Edgar Dobson, Foreman of the Grand Jury, called at the office of the Board and requested, verbally, that the ballot boxes in the following named precincts used in the election, held in Baltimore City, May 2nd., 1911, be produced before the Grand Jury on Monday, November 20, 1911, v i z:

5th. Ward.....Precincts 5, 6 and 10.

23rd. Ward.....Precinct 8,

7th. Ward.....Precinct 5.

It was ordered that the ballot boxes above referred to be produced before the Grand Jury, as requested by the Foreman thereof.
