A communication, as follows, was received and the offers as therein contained to overhaul and repair the automobile used by the Marshal, including the installation of high tension system of ignition, were accepted:

Dear Sir:-

Referring to our conversation several days ago relative to your type "L" 30 H.P. Locomobile, we agree to overhaul the chassis of this car thoroughly for the sum of \$350.00. This price includes the new 1912 Carbeurettor which cost \$38.00 and the old one returned and which by our experience with other cars of this model, pays for itself in the saving of gasoline consumed, as well as many other features, including smoothness of running and more power and easy starting of motor.

It is understood that in the event of the time and material necessary to put this car in perfect shape, would be less than the above \$350.00, we will give you the benefit of same. In the event of exceeding the above mentioned \$350.00, we will withstand the difference ourselves.

Relative to the High Tension system of ignition, we can put this on your car for a net extra charge of \$94.00, as you already have a Storage Battery and Box for your Klaxon Horn. This same battery would answer the purpose of starting and supply the battery ignition to your motor, as well as the horn.

We believe that it would be a good idea to have this ignition put on, as it would cost approximately forty to forty-five dollars to thoroughly overhaul the present system of ignition and therefore your new system would only mean an outlay of about \$50.00. Added to this the High Tension would make less noise, throttle down better and give more uniform service.

We also agree to loan you a car at no charge while the work is being done on your car.

It is understood that this work does not include repairs to the tires or painting of the car.
