Motor Vehicles Entering & Leaving Garages.

Instructions, as follows, were adopted, upon the subject of Motor Vehicles entering and leaving garages:

Complaints have been made to this office of the utter want of care on the part of some drivers of motor vehicles entering and leaving garages fronting on the public streets, and instances have been brought to the attention of the department wherein women and children using the sidewalk, have been shocked and narrowly escaped serious injury by such recklessness.

It is the duty of the department to intervene in such a matter for the safeguarding of pedestrians in their rightful use of the sidewalks, and to see to it that due precaution is exercised by drivers of such vehicles.

It therefore requires:-

That motor vehicles entering garages fronting on the public streets, shall slow up or stop at the curb line and signal by horn to persons passing along the sidewalk, before proceeding across the pavement.

And that the drivers of motor vehicles in leaving such garages, shall either send a man ahead to see that the way is clear before starting out with the machine, or stop at the building line, signal by horn, and ascertain themselves that the way is clear before proceeding over the sidewalk.

Notice shall be given ~~the~~ proprietors or managers of garages fronting on the public streets of these requirements,
