"Baltimore, Md., August 6th., 1912.

Thomas F. Farnan, Marshal of Police.

Sir:-

Referring to the attached requisitions of Cap't J.J. Santry, Northwestern District, namely:

Separating the two water-closets by the placing of a partition between them, also new doors, in order to insure privacy between the sexes;

Closet in the yard, between the manure pit and prison wall, for the use of stable-men;

New tank for water-closet in Matron's toilet: second floor.

Syphon ball for closet; second floor back;

Two hoppers for water-closets in prison on first floor;

Two new spigots in wash-room, second floor.

I find that these improvements are absolutely needed and I would therefore respectfully recommend that the same be made.
