Census of Voting Population.

In respect to the books used in taking the census of the voting population by members of the Police Force, as required by law, it was ordered, that the said books shall at the end of each day's work be deposited by the officers taking the census, at their respective station-house and kept thereat over night, and no information given therefrom to persons outside of the Police Department; that, upon the completion of the census, the books shall be copied at the station-houses exclusively; that copies thereof be furnished the officers of Registration, as provided by law, and the original census books transmitted to the Office of the Board of Police Commissioners that they may, under the direction of the Board, be accessible alike to all applicants for information therefrom.
