In the matter of the damage to the Police Patrol Boat LANNAN, as referred to in the proceedings of September 3rd, 1912, a report, as follows, was received:

SIR:-

In reference to the damage to the Police Patrol Boat LANNAN at the fire of the Steamship NANTUCKET of the Merchants and Miners Transportation Company, September 2nd, 1912, by their Tug NONPARIEL, I hereby report, that I took the LANNAN to the Marine Railway and Boiler Works, and they looked the damage over, and said it would cost about \$150.00 to repair the same.

I also took the LANNAN to the Merchants and Miners Transportation Company, and they said they could do the work at their shop for about \$100.00, and that they would like to make the repairs. They said they would communicate with the Board in regard to the same. They also said they did not know that their boat had damaged our boat, as it was not reported to them by the captain of their boat, or they would have been to see about it; that they are very sorry it happened.
