

Corporation of Annapolis Deed dated 13 August 1752

to
Lancelot Auguer : for all that parcel of Land ~~beginning at~~
said Act for the building a Markett House thereon, beginning at
Locust Post Standing in the head line of the ~~old~~ land and at the
end of Church Street and running with part of the breadth of the
said Street North five degrees, West twenty five feet to a Cedar
Post standing at One corner of the Free School Land then with the
line of the Land formerly laid out for Francis Nicholson Esq.
South eighty four degrees East three hundred and sixty feet to a
~~Another~~ Cedar Post Standing ~~at an~~ near the water then South fifty
degrees West Sixty feet to another Cedar Post Standing near
the water then by a straight line to the beginning Locust
Post containing and now laid out for twelve thousand
seven hundred and thirty three Square feet of Ground more
or less.
