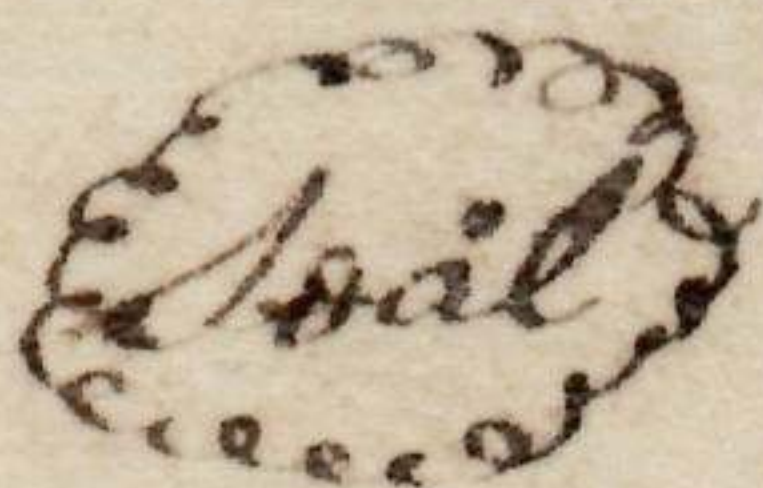


Purposes In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my

and made Oath that they Saw John Ewitts the Testator herein
named Sign and Seal this Codicil and heard him Publish-
Pronounce and Declare the same to be a Codicil to his Last
Will and Testament and that at the time of his so doing he
was of a sound Disposing mind memory and understanding to
the Best of their Apprehensions and that they severally Signed
their names as Witnesses to this Will in the Presence and at the
Request of the Testator and in the presence of Each other.
