I have sent down by Capt. Curtis Revel, schooner Minerva, about 5,000 white Oak Staves to: of him, at Twenty Dollars the 1000, you will have them cut out & counted pay him for what ever quantity he may have, at the rate of \$200 \$ thousand & the cullings in proportion, I have also put on board, Capt. Revel about 1500 more, which is out of another vessel and he has taken them down on freight which you will please pay him, when he delivers them, the freight only on the ones sent by him is to be paid, I suppose this quantity will be sufficient and can send you some heading down if you want it
