

Baltimore June 5 1821

Dear Sir

On Saturday afternoon I went to see Mr Pinkney & had a long conversation with him. I mentioned to him your wish to be appointed Navy Store Keeper at Annapolis, provided Mr Cathcart should not accept, he replied he knew you well, and had a great regard & affection for you & would cheerfully do any thing in his power for you. He said he should be at Annapolis in a few days. I would see you on the subject, perhaps you had better wait on him, ^{as} soon as he reaches your City.

Commodore Porter is expected in Town tomorrow, when I shall see him, I will not fail of bringing your case before him.
